

## Pass SB 1090 — Call the Committee Members

Two Assembly committees hear SB 1090 on **July 1**. Your calls decide it. Each call takes about two minutes.

### □ YOUR 30-SECOND CALL SCRIPT

SB 1090 puts a narrow, temporary pause on urban lot splits in Altadena, protecting responsible and resilient recovery pathways while taking no housing away. We deserve **parity** with the Palisades. And it should not be easier for a developer to build than for a survivor to rebuild.

We also **support the amendment allowing SB 9 projects for 100% deed-restricted low-to-moderate-income affordable housing** — so Altadena can rebuild its income diversity and bring renters and working families home.

Please vote AYE on SB 1090 and make it effective as soon as possible. Thank you."
